## Dock Diving Seminars With 'G' Gulnaz Zagidullina

Gulnaz ("G") is an experienced, well-educated, and motivational dog trainer that makes her training approach totally unique. "G" started training dogs over 10 years ago with her first German Shepherd Volcha. During this time "G" trained Volcha in Obedience, Tracking, Frisbee, Canine Freestyle Dancing, Search and Rescue, and Dock Diving. Volcha earned multiple Frisbee and Diving Dog titles across Canada and the USA. Together they became best friends, strong competitors which built a passion in her that led to helping others build the bond with their dogs.

Since 2016 Gulnaz "G" started traveling and performing with her dogs doing Dock Diving in stunt dog shows nationwide. In 2017 Volcha and "G" were invited for the NADD National Championship in Orlando, Florida and came back home to Canada with Reserved Champion (2nd place overall in Air retrieve Master Division). In 2018 she started teaching swimming classes for dogs in Calgary. In 2019 "G" became a Judge for the North America Diving Dogs (NADD).

Currently, "G" has two dogs competing in Dock Diving:

**Volcha NADD Elite division in distance jump and Master division in Air retrieve.**

**Maaya NADD Master division in distance jump and Master division in Air retrieve.**

As we all know trust and bond are critical in working with dogs. If you are excited and want to learn more or even get into dog competitions, Gulnaz has developed her own proven training techniques and relationship skill building to help those who want to learn and compete in Dock Diving as well as many other dog sports.

With her experience in the top levels of the sport of dock diving, she can definitely help any dog and handler improve their game."

**Introduction to Dock Diving:** This seminar assumes your dog already enjoys being in water and loves to swim and retrieve. Your dog will be introduced to the dock safely and in a positive manner. You and your dog will get coached on how to find the ramp safely and get back on the dock. You will learn how to encourage your dog to jump off the dock safely to retrieve their toy using positive training methods.

**Combination: Refine your Jump/Games, Air Retrieve & Hydro Dash:** This seminar is for dogs already jumping off the dock. We will teach you the difference between the "place and send" and the "chase" method, learn what method is best for your dog. The goal is to build confidence within your dog for more successful jumps.

You will have the opportunity to encourage your dog to jump off the dock to retrieve the bumper suspended from the Air Retrieve rig (height) or from the Hydro Dash rig (speed). You will encourage your dog to jump for the retrieve using positive training methods.

# *Rules of Conduct*



## **GENERAL RULES**

**No nose to nose contact with other dogs.** You are here to work and engage with your dog.

If a dog is handled in an aggressive or inappropriate manner a warning may be issued or the team may be asked to leave without refund(s).

Please show courtesy to all participants. Manage loud or disruptive dogs. Treat every dog as if they are reactive or spatially challenged.

Remain aware of what your dog is doing at all times. Every dog and participant deserve to have a pleasant experience.

**Potty your dog at least 40' away from any entrance/exit.**

It is preferred you potty your dog on the grass area at the front or back of the building. Do not potty your dog on the building, fence, vehicles, garbage cans, pylons, or anything not natural.

**YOU are responsible for picking up after your dog(s).** Failure to comply will result in dismissal and/or a one-year ban from the facility and events and no refund(s) will be issued.

Please bring your own water, water dish and poop bags for your dog(s).

Please bring clean indoor shoes.

Classes are bought as a package. There are no refunds or make-up classes, nor are they transferrable.

Seminars are to be paid in full. There are no refunds for seminars in the event of your absence, nor are they transferrable.

Only registered participants may attend Seminars. Audit spots are available.

## **CRATING OF YOUR DOG**

All dogs must be crated safely and securely when not working. **DO NOT** tie your dog(s) to anything.

If you do not have a crate you may rent one for a \$15 fee.

**DO NOT** approach crated dogs. If you do not have permission from the dog's owner, you are not permitted to approach a crated dog.

Keep your dog(s) away from crated dogs. **DO NOT** let your dog(s) approach a crated dog(s).

You may crate your dog(s) from your vehicle, weather permitting. Dogs crated in vehicles may be monitored by Prairie Dog Sports Inc. staff to ensure the safety of the dog(s) from adverse weather conditions.

**Acceptable crates** include those that have a solid frame once together to keep the crate stationary, i.e. soft crate, wire crate. Please secure zippers on soft crates with security clip to secure dog(s) in crate.

**Not acceptable crates** include x-pens and those that do not have a solid frame once together to keep the crate stationary, i.e. pop-ups.

## **ACCEPTABLE COLLARS**

Dogs must be kept on a 6' or shorter leash at all times.

Flexi leashes and long lines are not allowed on site.

Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction.

Limited slip martingale collars are allowed.

Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses are allowed.

Electronic collars/devices **ARE NOT** allowed anywhere on site – this includes electronic bark collars.

Prong or pinch collars and Haltis may be used on site while walking dog, but the collar must be removed before the dog/handler proceeds to work.



## **FEMALES IN SEASON**

Females in season ARE NOT permitted in the pool/dock.

Females in season ARE NOT permitted to attend seminars, unless otherwise stated.

Females in season ARE NOT permitted to attend class, unless otherwise stated.

## **VISITORS AND CHILDREN**

Visitors and children are not allowed at Seminars.

Visitors and children are welcome provided that the visits are infrequent, brief, and prior permission has been granted.

While visitor(s)/children are on site, they must always be directly supervised by the host/parent.

If the frequency, length, or nature of visits becomes problematic, the host/parent will be advised and will be expected to take corrective action.

**PRAIRIE DOG SPORTS INC.** reserves the right to refuse any person(s) and or dog(s) entry to the facility, events, and classes.

Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, participant/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in the event or training, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons. Everyone must be very careful to watch their dog(s) on the property, clean up after yourself and your dog(s). We reserve the right to excuse without refund of fees any person for what we deem excessive harshness. We reserve the right to excuse without refund of fees any person for what we deem as aggressive or abusive behaviour towards another person or dog.
